





ZOOM SUR: COLLINE DE L'HERMITAGE, A SYMBOLIC LANDMARK OFTHE RHÔNE VALLEY

The Colline de l'Hermitage : just a few words to describe this unique spot Famous hillsides, terraced vineyards, sometimes called « chalets » in French. The site covers 140 hectares where 35 winegrowers work to produce the famous « Hermitage » wine. This exceptional elixir is one of the three Ardèche Hermitage wine appellations. Once you reach the top push on a little further to the Chapelle de l'Hermitage that was once the home of Knight Sterimberg.

On foot, scooter, e-bike... an interesting place for enthusiasts of all kinds. It needs to be pointed out that this site has also been classified national heritage since 2013.

BICENTENAIRE DE LA PASSERELLE MARC SEGUIN

In 2025, the first bridge built by Marc Seguin between Tain l'Hermitage and Tournon celebrates its 200th anniversary. The first suspension bridge in France, it bears witness to the visionary ingenuity of its creator, engineer Marc Seguin, and remains a symbol of innovation and heritage. Today, the second bridge built by Mr Seguin and his brothers is a veritable emblem for the 2 towns.

THE TRUFFLE PATCH OF BAUME SAINT ANTOINE

Did you know? Drôme is the first French county to produce black truffles. TICKLE YOUR TASTE BUDS! THE POGNE OF MAISON RONJAT

An Easter tradition dating back to the Middle-ages, the "pogne" is a sort of brioche, flavoured with orange-flower whereas the similar St Genix with pralines, is a more recent creation. In Saint-Donat-sur-l'Herbasse, only a few steps away from the Palais Delphinal Collegiate, the 8th generation of Maison Ronjat closely guards secret the recipe for both these renowned, regional specialities. The Pogne of Maison Ronjat has had its trademark "Donatienne" (meaning originating from Saint Donat) since 1910. Although not as much a favourite as the one from Romans, it is without a doubt a unique recipe that every fine taste-bud should savor once in a lifetime! ronjat.com

CAILLÉ DOUX DE SAINT FÉLICIEN: BIRTH OF A PDO

The caillé doux, only farm produced, is a flat cylinder-shape, soft raw goat's milk cheese with a blooming crust. Its name "doux" meaning mild, comes from the process of a fast curdling of the milk and is protected by a registered trademark. Not to be mistaken for the just-as-delicious Saint Félicien cheese!

HANDING DOWN TO THE NEXT GENERATION

Conscious of the rich resources of our region the various professionals of Ardèche Hermitage are constantly working towards a more responsible tourism by respecting nature, protecting natural resources and promoting a cultural diversity. Good examples are the installation of solar panels on the river vessel « Bike'n boat » and the ambition of the Cité du Chocolat to become the first eco-responsible tourist site in Drôme. Just like its fellow partners, the Tourist Office team is working towards a certain sustainablility.



1001 CORNES: ANIMAL FARM OF RARE AND ENDANGERED SPECIES

At the heart of Drôme des Collines, this animal farm is specialized in protecting species with over 150 animals. Amongst them are 25 goat and sheep breeds either rare or close to extinction. THE « CAILLÉ DOUX » FEMALE WORKFORCE OF SAINT FÉLICIEN

Why a female workforce? As Isabelle Thomas the president well explains, the idea stems naturally from the history of this cheese. It brought to light the role of women and the importance of female labour in its making fom start to finish along with the handing down of their know-how. « It's a women's business, it's a women's story! They handed down this history that we are proud to add to our rich, cultural heritage. Nowadays, we are proud to be the ambassadors of this fine cheese made in North Ardèche and certainly worth tasting. »





BOUCIEU LE ROI, VILLAGE AUX MILLE SECRETS

Classed as a French "Village and City of character", in 1291 Boucieu-le-Roi became the seat of a Bailiwick, in other words a royal court of justice covering the Haut-Vivarais area until it was replaced by the town of Annonay in 1565. Nicknamed "village of 1000 secrets" Boucieu-le-Roi is quite surprising with its ancient buildings and its history to be discovered when you visit the village museum and exhibition of regional traditions. The village is also the departure point for the Doux Gorges Railbike circuit. A place not to be missed for enthusiasts of history and old stones. boucieuleroi.com

>ZOOM SUR: BATHERNAY: A SMALL VILLAGE WITH A BIG HISTORY

Bathernay is a tiny hilltop village in Drôme des Collines offering a splendid panoramic view over the surrounding countryside. A certain Imbert was born here. He was Lord of France and the advisor to 4 of our Kings and last but not least grandfather of the well-known Diane of Poitiers. Denis Deroux who is mayor of the village and promoter of its attractive bell tower tells the story with passion. A permanent mark of Imbert remains even today with a prestigious descendance: his Serene Highness Prince Albert II of Monaco. Due to this family relation the historical site is now named Grimaldi de Monaco.

TOURNON CASTLE: ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL VIEWS OF THE RHÔNE VALLEY

Perched on a rocky cliff, Tournon Castle, with its avant-garde Renaissance architecture, **is worth** the visit if only for its terraces and panoramic view over the town, the Rhône river and the famous Hermitage hillside. The site is brimming with history and nowadays, houses a museum (with the Musée de France label) displaying a rich collection of paintings from the Renaissance period up to present day. Both a remembrance site and a cultural venue, the castle holds several temporary exhibitions each year as well as other events (escape game, chasse aux oeufs, concerts...) highlighting its architecture. chateaumusee-tournon.com



ZOOM SUR : LTHE REBIRTH OF THE CHÂTEAU DE FONTAGER

A gem of architecture and steeped in history, the Château de Fontager in Serves-sur-Rhône was built by the Romans. Property of a Danishman for the last 25 years, the edifice underwent extensive refurbishment before it re-opened in 2022. **Elegance and refinement are the key words** for this site that offers 32 guest rooms, several private salons and meeting rooms, not forgetting its splendid 35 by 19-metre pool in the summer set in a woodland park. <u>chateaudefontager.fr</u>
